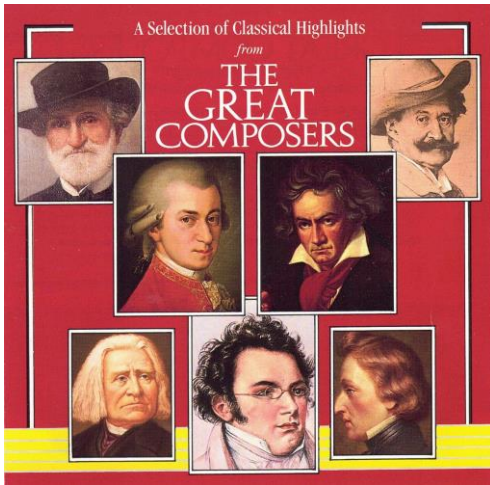

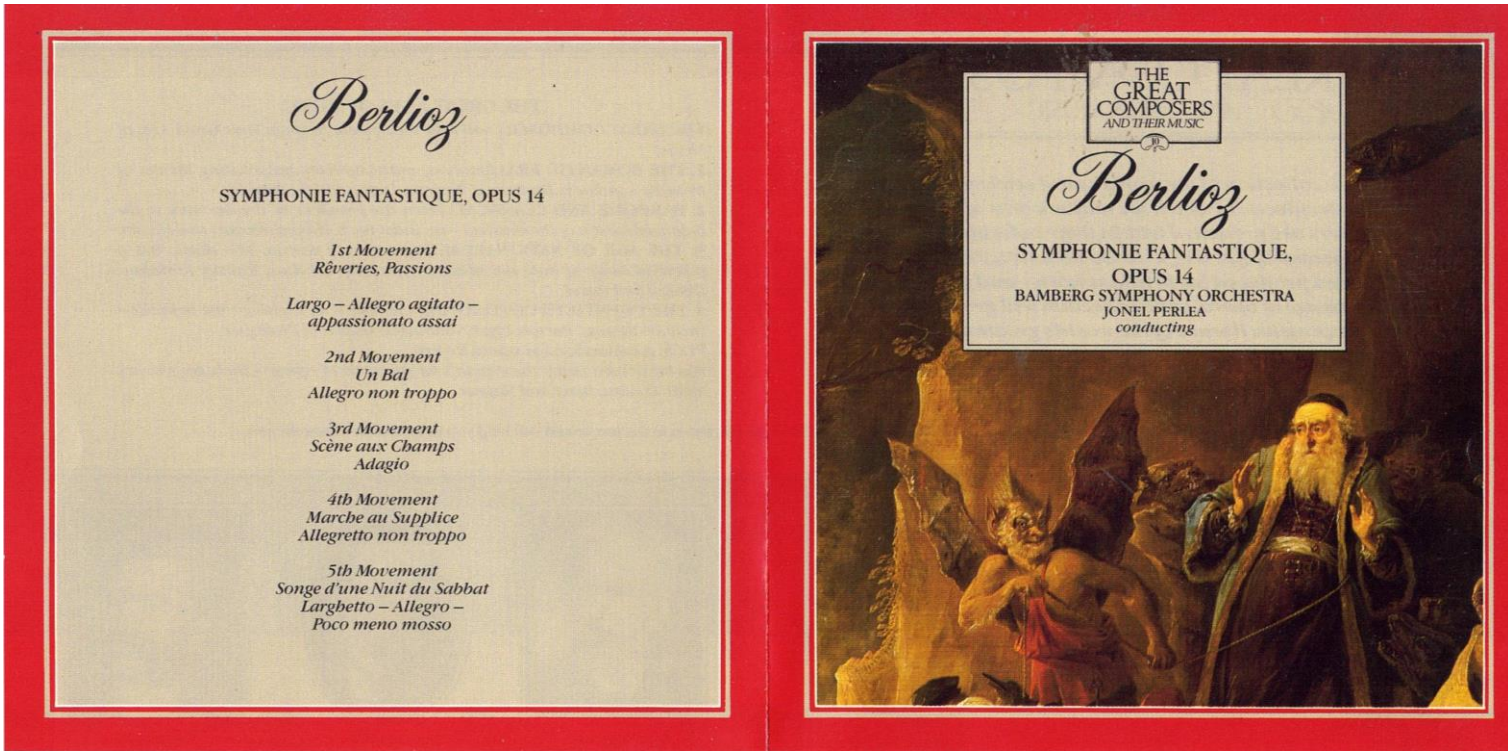

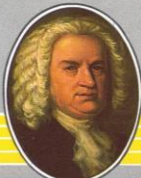

THE GREAT AGES OF MUSIC

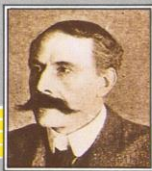
THE GREAT COMPOSERS will take the listener through Four Great Ages of Music.

1. THE ROMANTIC ERA: Emotion, individualism and exciting themes of freedom – includes Beethoven, Brahms, Liszt and Tchaikovsky.
2. BAROQUE AND CLASSICAL: From the grandeur of the Baroque to the balanced reason of the classical – includes Bach, Handel, Mozart and Haydn.
3. THE AGE OF NATIONALISM: Beginning in Russia, this music has a powerful sense of national identity – includes Sibelius, Rimsky-Korsakov, Dvorak and Ravel.

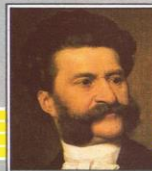
