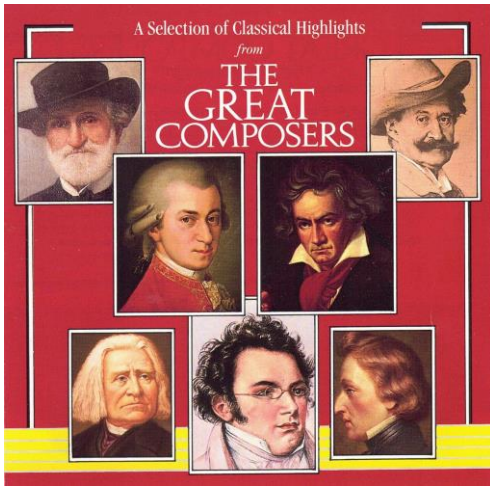

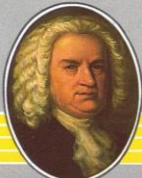

THE GREAT AGES OF MUSIC

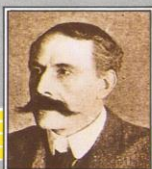
THE GREAT COMPOSERS will take the listener through Four Great Ages of Music.

- 1. THE ROMANTIC ERA:** Emotion, individualism and exciting themes of freedom – includes Beethoven, Brahms, Liszt and Tchaikovsky.
- 2. BAROQUE AND CLASSICAL:** From the grandeur of the Baroque to the balanced reason of the classical – includes Bach, Handel, Mozart and Haydn.

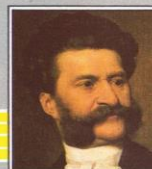
